No original corner evidence found.

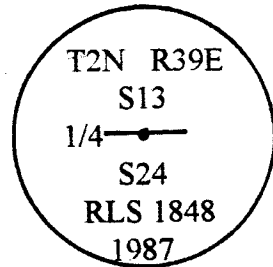
