

#### TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:


At proportionate position, I set a 2 ½"x30" aluminum pipe monument with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 28 inches in the ground, in a collar or stone 1 ft. diam., from which:


- A 17 inch Douglas Fir bears North 43° East, a distance of 19.90 feet, marked 1/4 S19 BT.
- A 9 inch White Fir bears South 1° East, a distance of 23.80 feet, marked 1/4 S19 BT.
- A 16 inch Douglas Fir bears South 30° West, a distance of 18.55 feet, marked 1/4 S24 BT.
- An 11 inch Douglas Fir bears North 20° West, a distance of 48.55 feet, marked 1/4 S24 BT.

I set a steel fence post approximately one foot North of corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on May 15, 2013.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing tree.
