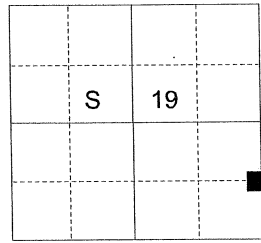

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 29 inches in the ground, from which:

A 7 inch White Fir bears South 60° East, a distance of 23.05 feet, marked S 1/6 S20 BT.

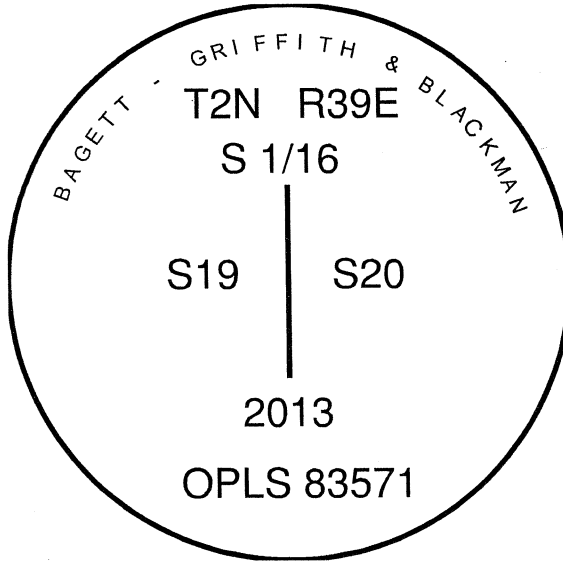
A 4 inch White Fir bears North 18° West, a distance of 13.00 feet, marked X BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing tree.
