
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Rufus S. Moore under GLO contract number 382, dated March 23rd, 1881. GLO record states:

Set post for cor to secs 19 and 30, from which:
A tamarack 20 in. diam. bears N62°W, 41 lks. dist.
A tamarack 15 in. diam. bears S53°W, 30 lks. dist.
A tamarack 10 in. diam. bears S52°E, 31 lks. dist.
A tamarack 15 in. diam. bears N9°W, 11 lks. dist.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a 2 ½"x30" aluminum pipe monument with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 27 inches in the ground, from which:

- A 13 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 28° East, a distance of 40.90 feet, marked T2N R39E S19 BT.
- A 10 inch White Fir bears South 15° East, a distance of 23.40 feet, marked T2N R38E S30 BT.
- An 11 inch Western Larch bears South 58° West, a distance of 20.60 feet, marked T2N R38E S25 BT.
- An 11 inch Douglas Fir bears North 8° West, a distance of 19.25 feet, marked T2N R38E S24 BT.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing tree.
