

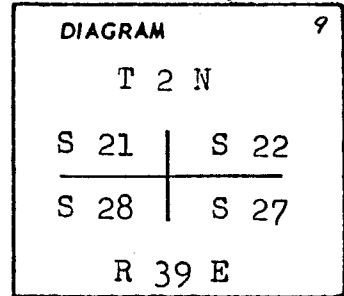
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

R-13

History of original corner establishments:

A wooden post was set for this section corner from which the following bearing trees were set:

- A pine 40" dia. bears N 58 E 47 lks.
- A pine 44" dia. bears N 45 W 9 lks.
- A pine 24" dia. bears S 76 W 129 lks.
- A pine 26" dia. bears S 71 E 206 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found evidence of charred 44" pine stump and evidence of stumps and stump holes of remaining bearing trees which fit the descriptions set forth in the GLO notes, though I found no scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Restored the section corner by using the GLO call distance and bearings. Set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a cap stamped RLS 645 in a large mound of stone. I then set four new bearing trees as follows:

- A pine 14" dia. which bears N 04 W, 119.9 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 21 BT.
- A pine 10" dia. which bears S 28 W, 71.8 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 28 BT.
- A pine 14" dia. which bears S 76 E, 122.8 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 27 BT.
- A pine 12" dia. which bears N 44 E, 102.2 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 22 BT.

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

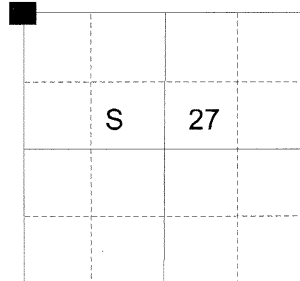
Corner originally established by Rufus Moore in GLO contract no. 382, dated March 23, 1881. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set post for Cor to Secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, from which:
A pine 40 in. diam. bears N58°E, 47 lks. dist.
A pine 44 in. diam. bears N45°W, 9 lks. dist.
A pine 24 in. diam. bears S76°W, 129 lks. dist.
A pine 26 in. diam. bears S71°E, 206 lks. dist.

In Survey Number 108-77, James Hambleton monuments the corner from original evidence. From which:
A 14" Pine bears N4°W, 119.9 ft.
A 12" Pine bears N44°W, 102.2 ft.
A 14" Pine bears S76°E, 122.8 ft.
A 10" Pine bears S28°W, 71.80 ft.

Corner as per Hambleton, is found and accepted by Barry Barbour in Survey Number 33-79.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 1" O.D. iron pipe, 3 in. above ground, in a collar of stone, 3 ft. diam., from which:
A 24" Fir stump bears South 76° East, a distance of 122 ft, with healed blaze evident.
A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears South 28° West, a distance of 71.8 ft. alive and vigorous with healed blaze.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

From the iron pipe,

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears North 68° East, a distance of 25.60 feet, marked T2N R39E S21 BT.
A 7" Ponderosa Pine bears South 38° East, a distance of 31.40 feet, marked T2N R39E S27 BT.
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 9° West, a distance of 40.05 feet, marked T2N R39E S22 BT.

Corner falls 1.5 feet South of an East/West fenceline.
I hereby certify that the corner was perpetuated on August 21, 2014.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination. The distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
