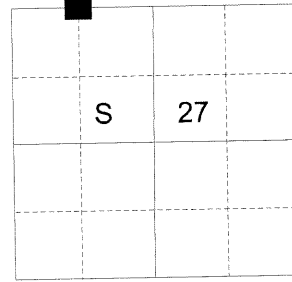

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED**

**TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 24 inches in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

An 8 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 8° East, a distance of 44.80 feet, marked W 1/16 S27 BT.

An 11 inch Ponderosa Pine bears West, a distance of 31.00 feet, marked W 1/16 S22 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument. Corner falls approximately 9.5 feet North and 7.6 feet East of a fence corner.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on August 28, 2014.

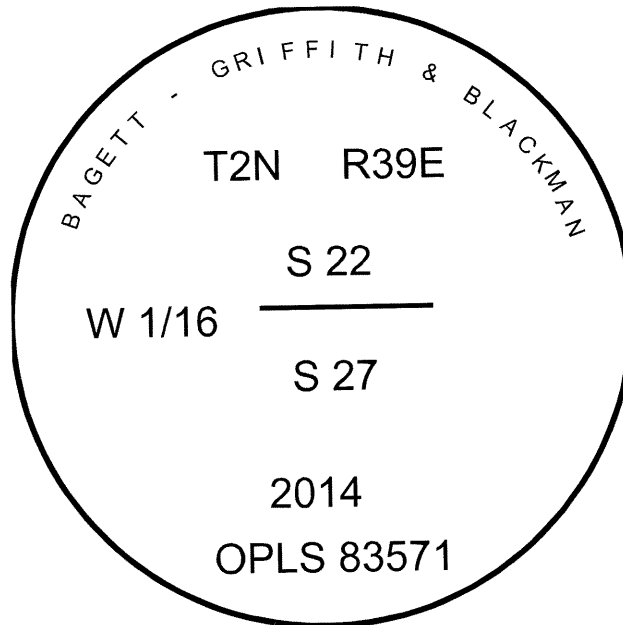

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination. The distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the bearing trees.
