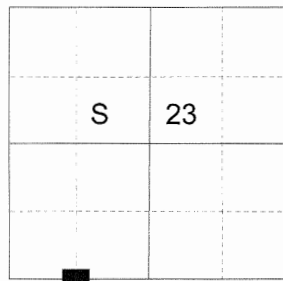

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown, 25" in the ground with collar of stone 2 ft. diam.,

from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 20" Ponderosa Pine bears North 8° East, a distance of 44.85 feet, marked W 1/16 S23 BT.
An 18" Ponderosa Pine bears South 4° West, a distance of 18.20 feet, marked W 1/16 S26 BT.

East/West fence bears approx. 1' North of monument

North/South bearing fence bears approx. 15' West of monument

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearing is to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the tree. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the tree.
