Description of corner evidence found:

Found evidence of the bearing tree stumps located in sections 24 25, and 26. Though stumps were badly rotted they fit the GLO call bearings and distances.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Restored section corner to its original position, using the GLO notes, thus I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with cap stamped RLS 645, in a mound of stone. I then set four new bearing trees as follows:

A fir 5" dia. which bears N 70 E, 16.3 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 24 BT.

A fir 10" dia. bears S 58 E, 24.5 feet, scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 25 BT.

A fir 11" dia. bears S 41 W, 48.3 feet, scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 26 BT.

A larch 4" dia. bears N 27 W, 16.3 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 23 BT.
