

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 29 inches in the ground, with 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

An 8 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North  $27^{\circ}$  East, a distance of 68.65 feet, marked NW 1/16 S27 BT.

An 11 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North  $80^\circ$  West, a distance of 42.55 feet, marked NW 1/16 S27 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument. Corner falls approximately 4.3 feet North of a fence corner. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on August 28, 2014.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination. The distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the bearing trees.
