
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 1 1/4" pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap, flush with the ground, marked as shown below and in a 3 ft. collar of stone, from which:

A 20" diam. Ponderosa Pine bears South 50° East, a distance of 65.10 ft., dead and standing with healed blaze.

A 26" diam. Ponderosa Pine bears South 31° West, a distance of 35.00 ft., alive and vigorous with healed blaze

The cap falls in an East/West fence line nearly under a rock jack and approx. 10 ft. East from a fence corner to East/South/West bearing fence lines.
