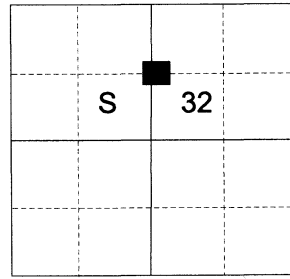

At position by survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown, from which:

**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

A 13" Douglas Fir bears North 44° East a dist. of 11.35 ft., marked CN 1/16 S32 BT

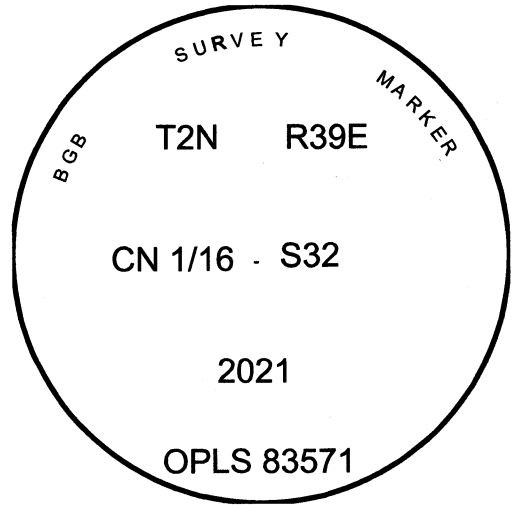
A 13" Douglas Fir bears South 72° West a dist. of 6.15 ft., marked CN 1/16 S32 BT

Set steel fence post approx. 0.2 feet Southeasterly

A North/South bearing fence line falls approx. 13 feet East

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
