
## **UNION COUNTY** CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was never set.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

See Map of Survey Number 015-1992.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey, I set a  $5/8" \times 30"$  rebar with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which:

A 8" Ponderosa Pine bears S60°E, 19.15 feet, marked X BT


A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears S79°W, 9.27 feet, marked C-N 1/16 S 10 BT

Set steel fence post 1 foot south.

There is a fence corner 91 feet south and 100 feet east, fences running N-S-E.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on May 15, 1992.
