
History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 4 ft. high stump 18-ins. diam at record bearing and distance for Sec. 16 BT (N. 51° W., 33 lks. dist.) This BT was part of a N-S running fence; old barbed wire still protruding from stump. The scribing $^{"}/_{4}$ is visible.

No evidence of the other original BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $1\frac{1}{2}$ -inch O.D. iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ -inch brass cap in small stone mound at record bearing and distance. Pipe is 30 inches long, set 26 inches in the ground.

Set a steel fence post alongside with USFS Sign No. 54-4 attached.

Attached a USFS BT tag and 54-4 tag to the BT stump.
