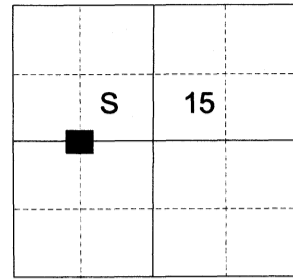

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At position by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 24" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown and in a 2 ft. diam. collar of stone, from which:

**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

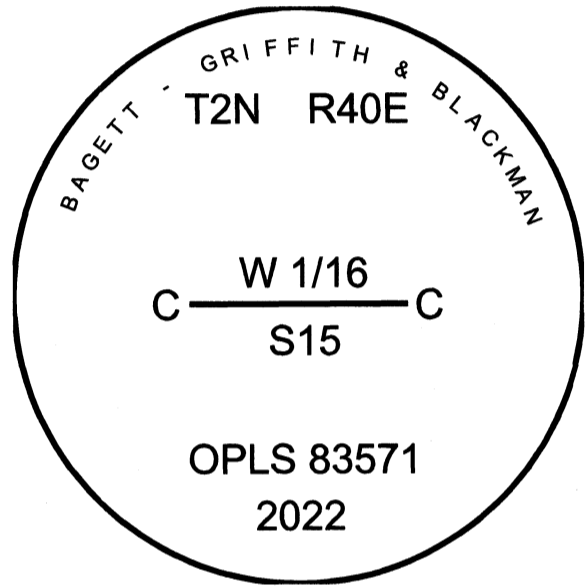
A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 0°09' East a dist. of 30.00 ft., marked "N RP BGB SURVEY MARKER"  
A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 43°06' West a dist. of 30.00 ft., marked "NW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER"

Set steel fencepost approx. 0.5 ft. Northwest

Fence corner to North/South/West bearing fencelines bears approx. 80 ft. Southeasterly
