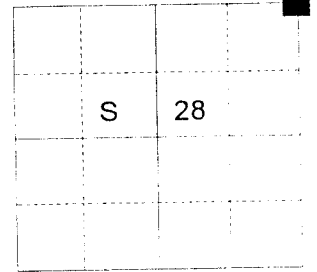


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Rufus S. Moore under GLO contract number 382, dated March 23rd, 1881. GLO record states:

T 2 N R 40 E R-13



Set post for Cor. to Sec. 21, 22, 27, & 28 from which:

- A Pine 5" Diam bears N 18° E 91 lks dist
- A pine 10" Diam bears N 72 ° W 180 lks dist
- A Pine 34" Diam bears S 65° W 110 lks dist
- A Pine 36" Diam bears S 57 ° E 30 lks dist

No record of subsequent monumentation found in UNION COUNTY survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 24" stump bears S 65° W 110 lks. Lower BT blaze and chop marks were visible.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At record bearing and distance from the found stump, I set a 2 1/2 x 30" Aluminum Pipe with Cap, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

- An 8" Ponderosa Pine bears N 56° E, a distance of 57.03 feet, marked X BT
- A 12 1/2 " Ponderosa Pine bears S 79 ° E, a distance of 60.02 feet marked T 2 N, R 40 E, S27, BT.
- A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears S 10° W, a distance of 102.86 feet, marked T 2 N, R 40 E, S28, BT.
- A 5/8" Iron Rebar with 1 1/2" Aluminum Cap bears N 32° W, a distance of 21.00 feet, marked NW, RP.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 18° East declination, the distances are to the center of the reference object. BT distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown. A brass washer marked OPLS 991 is attached to the BT Blaze.
