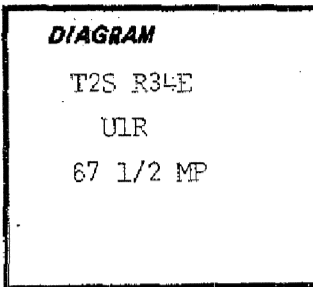

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. MP 67 1/2

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was recovered by L. Wilkes, survey group No. 38, in October, 1917. Surveyors General's notes state: "Intersect the 67 1/2 Mile cor., which is a basalt stone, 16x12x8 ins. marked but not legible. in a mound of stone. Reset above stone, 12 ins. in the ground and marked it 67 1/2 M on W face and UR on N face; from which: A pine, 24 ins. dia. bears N45°30'E, 175 lks. dist. marked UR1/2M BT (Old BT). A fir, 10 ins. diam. bears N82°30'W, 350 lks. dist. marked UR67 1/2M BT."



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 15x12x6 inch stone firmly set and marked UR on north side. From which: A 30" pine bears N46°E, 115.7 ft. with partially opened blazes and scribing. A 24" fir bears N82°W, 217.8 ft. visible scribing on partially opened blaze.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the above stone set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 22" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap. Buried marked stone alongside. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 12" pine bears S42°E, 18.2 ft. scribed URMP67 1/2 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3, 54-4 and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-3 and 54-4 on old BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' east of the corner.
