A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 18° W., $133\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. CC S35 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and set a steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post.

The corner is located on gentle SW. slope.

From this point, the $63\frac{1}{2}$ Mile Corner on the S. bdy. of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, bears N. 89° 47' 00" W., 14.875 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The postion of the township covered by this survey is located in the foothills of the Blue Mountains in Umatilla and Union Counties, 18 to 24 miles southeast of the town of Pendleton, Oregon. The elevations range from 4000 feet above sea level in section 33, to 4460 feet above sea level at the corner of sections 16, 17, 20, and 21.

The township is reached by way of U.S. Highway No. 395 south out of Pendleton, Oregon, to Pilot Rock, Oregon, thence southeast on East Birch Creek Road to the west boundary of the township. From there numerous gravelled and dirt roads provide access to the interior of the township.
