The original N.E. bearing tree, a $\underline{\text{found}}$ 22" Ponderosa Pine alive with opened blaze and visible scribing " /4". At location of corner found remains of rotted Pine post. No signs of SW BT, which falls in a power line right-of-way.

At the true corner point established by reference to the original NE bearing tree, we set a $2\ 1/2$ " by 30" galvanized pipe 20" in the ground with 3" brass cap stamped:
