

A Fir 12" dia. with axed open blaze and visible scribing "5 E 7" bears \$79°W 19.1 ft.

A Fir 17" dia. with healed over blaze bears S18°E 22.45 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the <u>true corner point</u> established by reference to the original bearing trees as described above, we set a 2"x30" galvanized Iron Pipe with brass cap, marked:
