

At the position determined by the survey I set a 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which;


NEW BEARING TREES:

A 12" Tamarack bears S79°W, 35.70 feet, marked C 1/4 S6 BT.


A 16" Tamarack bears N4°W, 54.57 feet, marked C 1/4 BT.

Corner established by using erroneous position of Township corner. From the true position:

- A 2 ½" aluminum pipe with cap marked as shown bears East, a distance of 7.1 feet
- A 15" Western Larch bears North 15° East, a distance of 55.49 feet, with a healed blaze
- A 9" Western Larch bears South 55° East, a distance of 13.02 feet, with a healed blaze.
- An 11" Western Larch bears South 74° West, a distance of 28.78 feet, with a healed blaze.


NEW BEARING TREE:

A 9 inch Douglas Fir bears North 64° West, a distance of 37.36 feet, marked C 1/4 S6 BT.


I remove the cap off the old monument and replace the bearing tree tags.
