North on west boundary of Section 7.

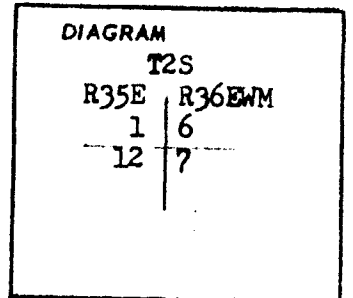
80.00 chains set a basalt stone 18x12x8, 8" in ground for corner of Sec. 6, 7, 8 and 12 from which;

Fir 20" in dia S46°E 15 lks marked T2S R36E S7BT;

No other tree near.

Pine stump 18" in dia N35°W 38 lks. with scribe;

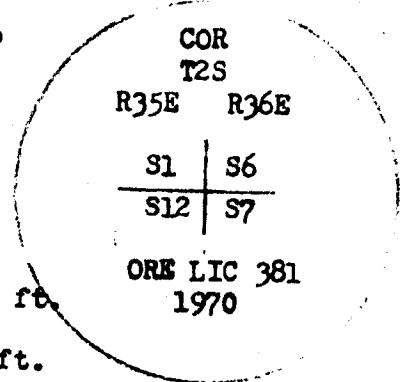
Fir stump 20" in diam S46°E 15 lks with scribe;

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30" pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil

I stamped the cap



From the monument the original bearing trees are;

(none) I established the following new bearing trees;

A Ponderosa pine 12" in diam N41°W at distance of 31.2 ft. and scribed T2S, R35E S1 BT;

A ponderosa pine 14" in diam N16°E at distance of 27.1 ft. scribed T2S, R36E, S6 BT;

A ponderosa pine 12" in diam S46°E a distance of 27.4 ft. scribed T2S, R36E, S7, BT;

A ponderosa pine 10" in diam S54°W at distance of 9.4 ft. scribed T2S, R35E, S12BT;

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level. I placed bearing tree signs on both old and new bearing trees and painted stripe around trees

I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached near the corner.
