

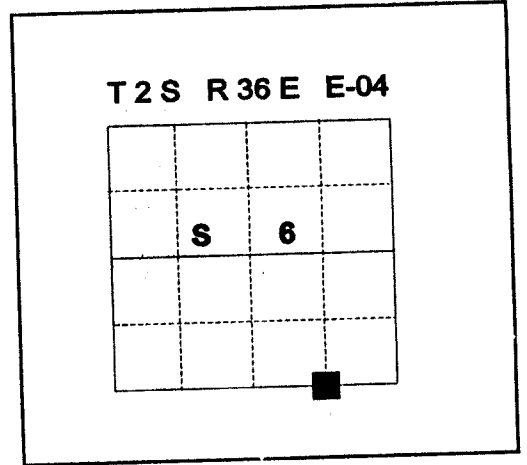

At the position determined by the survey I set a 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with  
aluminum cap marked as shown, 12 inches in the ground with a mound of stones  
3 feet base to top of cap, from which;

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 9" Tamarack bears N7°E, 56.10 feet, marked E 1/16 S6 BT.  
A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears S17°E, 73.12 feet, marked E 1/16 S7 BT.

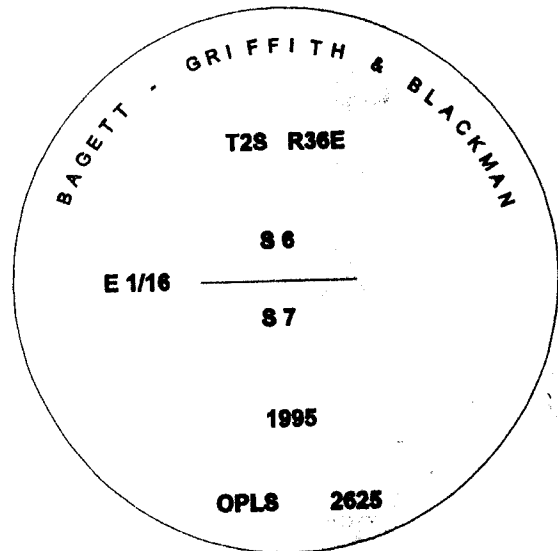
