Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 19 ins. diam., bears N. $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 92 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S9 BT.

Deposit corner stone alongside iron post

The cor. of aecs. 3, 4, 9, and 10, determined at record distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A western larch, 17 ins. diam. bears N. 60° E., 30 lks. dist., with scribe bark S visible on partially healed blaze.

A western larch, 90 ins. diam., bears S. 71° E., 33 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A western larch, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 78 lks. dist., we man's visible on partially healed blaze. (Record, N. 32° W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

A western larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S. $32\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 21 1ks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT.

Deposit fir post remains alongside iron post.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with a basalt stone, 15 x 12 x 10 ins., loosely set in a mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A root hole, bears S. 66° E., 40 lks. dist, with a down fir snag alongside, 30 ins. diam, with scribe marks $^1\!4$ S BT visible on open and decayed double blaze.

Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.

The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, monumented with a basalt stone, 15 x 12 x 8 ins., firmly set 6 ins. in a mound of stone, 2 ft. pase, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, mkd. with 4 grooves on E. and 1 g oove on S. faces, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A pine, 22 irs. diam., bears S. 73° W., 146 lks. dist., with scribe marks R36E S32 visible on opened blaze.

A pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 70° W. 154 lks. dist. with healed blaze. (Record, 12 lks.)

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
