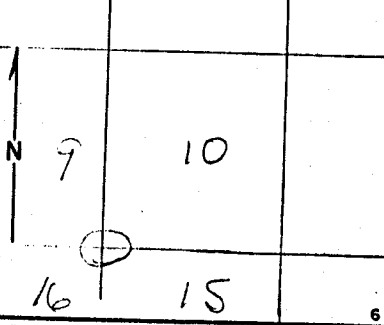

1 DESCRIBE CORNER MONUMENT FOUND  
The corner to sections 9, 10, 15 & 16 monumented with a basalt stone 17" x 10" x 6" (record 15" x 10" x 6") loosely set 3" in mound of stone marked with 3 grooves on E. face from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

2 DESCRIBE BEARING TREES OR OTHER OFFICIAL ACCESSORIES FOUND  
A pine 30" dia. bears N. 53° E. 90 lks. with scribe marks 2S 36E S10 visible on open base  
A sawed and decayed pine stump 27" dia. bears S. 32° E. 105 lks. no marking visible

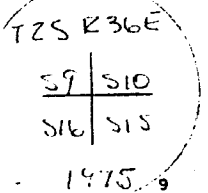

MONUMENT: DESCRIBE NEW MONUMENT SET, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE EXISTING MONUMENT

Set an iron post 28" long 2 1/2" dia. 16" in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone 4' base to top with brass cap marked

Remonumentation of Certain Original Corner Points,  
T. 2 S., R. 36 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 83½° E., 11 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S15 BT.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 26° W., 12 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S16 BT.

The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16, monumented with a basalt stone, 17 x 10 x 6 ins. (record, 15 x 10 x 6 ins., unmarked), loosely set 3 ins. in a mound of stone, mkd. with 3 grooves on E. face, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 53° E., 90 lks. dist., with scribe marks 2S 36E S10 visible on open blaze. (Record, N. 50° E.)

A sawed and decayed pine stump, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 32° E., 105 lks. dist., no marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 64½° E., 89 lks. dist., mkd. T2S R36E S15 BT.

A pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 60½° W., 79 lks. dist., mkd. T2S R36E S16 BT.

A pine, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 75½° W., 150 lks. dist., mkd. T2S R36E S9 BT.

Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 10, monumented with a basalt stone, 14 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set 6 ins. in the ground, mkd. ¼ on W. face and X on top, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 18° E., 75 lks. dist., with scribe mark T visible on opened blaze.

A sawed and decayed pine stump, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 114 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on decayed blaze.
