
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

In 1874, J. Hurlburt under GLO Contract No. 201 Set a Tamarack post, 4 ft. long, 3 ins. thick, 2 ft. in the ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor.

Pine 10 in. dia. S32° W 15 lks.

Pine 8 in. dia. S 62° E 36 lks.

A 15" Douglas Fir bears N 7 W 40.9 ft. scribed 1/4 S 13 BT. An 8" Tamarack bears S35 E 21.3'

Scribed 1/4 S 18 BT

Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to BT's. Painted blazes and 6" red ring around BT's.

Attached brass washers LS 1099 to foot blazes. Set metal post 5" north of corner with 54-4 sign. Corner falls on west slope 160' south of E-W draw and 495 ft. west of dirt road.
