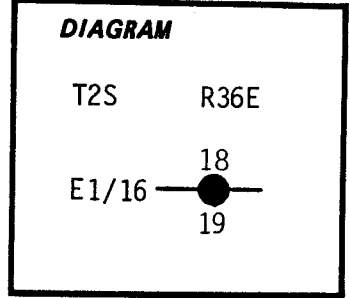


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Corner location determined by survey and single proportionate measurement between the N1/4 and NE corner of Section 19: T2S R36E S18

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap attached 24" in the ground stamped: E1/16 S19 1981 OR PLS 1099

From which:

A 13" Tamarack bears N48°W, 25.0 Ft. scribed E1/16 S18 BT.

A 12" Doug. Fir bears S43°W, 24.8 Ft. scribed E1/16 S19 BT.

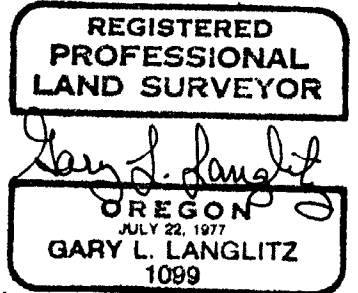
Attached 54-3 & 54-4 signs to BT's. Painted blazes & 6" red ring around BT's. Attached brass washers LS 1099 to foot blazes. Set metal fence post 5 Ft. South of corner with 54-2 & 54-4 signs. Set metal fence post 5 Ft. East of corner with 54-2 & 54-9 signs.

Corner falls on West slope 40 Ft. North of East-West draw.

Compass Declination: 18 1/2° East
