The original SW Bearing Tree, a down Fir, approx. 20" diameter we find axe marks and scribing "B" on a badly rotted face.

The original NE BT is gone except for a ground depression at its record location.

The original monument is gone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the True Corner Point, from which the identified remains of the original SW Bearing Tree bears $S8^{\circ}W$ 26.4 ft., we set a 2"x30" Galvanized Iron Pipe, 14 in. in the ground to bedrock and supported in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, with brass cap, stamped:

A 5/8" Iron Rod set by J. Voelz, LS 381, by survey as the 1/4 corner bears S53½° W 5.8 ft. (Refer to Union County Surveyor's Record Survey No. 87-74).

New Bearing Trees:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "1/4 S22 BT" on a double blaze bears S10°W 52.5 ft.

An 8" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S15 BT" on a double blaze bears N65° W 68.0 ft.

Placed steel fencepost approx. 5' West of monument. Painted trees attached signs per <u>Standard Specifications for Cadastral Survey</u>, U.S.F Region 6, October, 1979.
