

Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to BT's. Painted blazes and red 6" ring around BT's. Attached brass washers LS 1099 to foot blazes. Set metal fence post 5' west of corner with

54-2, 54-4 and 54-9 signs. Corner falls on east slope 150' west from bottom of wet weather stream 200' north of another wet weather stream and 225' east

of dead end on dirt road.

Compass Declination: 18 1/2° East. I hereby certify the above described corner monument and/or accessories was established as described on Nov. 10, 1981.
