Description of corner evidence found:

Found:

Root hole, approx. 4 1/2 ft. in diameter, with imbedded and burnt Pine roots, the remainder of the stump is gone.

No trace of the corner monument or SE bearing tree remains.

At a point established at record bearing and distance from the found Pine root hole, we find the following:

Stream, 7 ft. wide, flows East, bears South 66 feet. An 18" P. Pine, bears NW 10 ft. \pm . blazed on four sides, we open and date blazes at 50 years old.

Therefore, we accept the point as the original location of the 1/4 corner based on the found evidence described above and supported by actual survey.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point, we set a 2"x30" galvanized Iron Pipe, 26" in the ground and in a small mound of stone on a steep South slope, with brass cap, marked:

The remains of the original NW BT, a root hole, 4 1/2 ft. in diameter with imbedded pine roots bears N 50°W 13.2 ft. We mark new bearing trees:

A 12" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S21 BT" on a double blaze bears N 75 1/2°W 41.7 ft.

A 20" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S22 BT" on a double blaze bears N44°E 50.2 ft.

Placed steel fencepost approx. 5 ft. East of corner monument. Painted trees and attached signs per "Specifications for Cadastral Survey"
U.S.F.S. Region 6, Oct., 1979.

Corner located 50 ft. East of East R/W fence along I-84 freeway. Compass Declination: 18 1/2° East
