

History of original corner establishment: Corner not previously established.




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.


New BTs:

A 14 inch diameter double bole Ponderosa Pine bears S13°E, 12.36 feet marked C¼ S23 BT A 18 inch diameter double bole Ponderosa Pine bears N78°W, 7.20 feet marked X BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.
