
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John A. Hurlburt under GLO contract number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:

Set basalt stone 15x12x8, 8 in. in ground and made stone mound 2 ft. high for cor to sections 19-30-24-25.

Pine 15 in. dia. N70°E 61 lks

Fir 15 in. dia. S41°E 114 lks

Corner later found by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450 dated June 11, 1882. Mr. Meldrum set new corners for the township to the East of the range line. His notes state: Destroyed marks referring to Secs. 19 and 30.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found an axle driven in a large mound of stone.

Found a 20 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine stump, N70°E, 61 lks., with BT scribe visible.




