
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John A. Hurlburt under GLO contract number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:

Set pine post 4 ft. long 3 in. thick 2 ft. in ground for ¼ sec. cor.
Pine 15 in. dia. S70°W 53 lks
Tamarack 10 in. dia. N66°E 24 lks




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which:


New Bearing Trees: A 14 inch diameter Western Larch bears S33°E, 26.63 feet marked ¼ S35 BT A 8 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S77°W, 19.95 feet marked ¼ S34 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on May 5, 1989.
