

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Jacob C. Cooper under GLO contract no. 397 dated July 1, 1881.

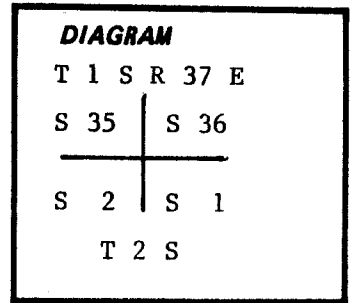
Surveyor General records state:

Set post 4½ ft long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground in dense forest of pine and fir timber on W. side of mountain 200 ft below the summit for cor to secs 1, 2, 35 and 36 marked T 1 S S 36 on NE, R 37 E S 1 on SE, T 2 S S 2 on SW and S 35 on the NW faces with 1 notch on the E. and 5 notches on the W. edges from which

- A fir 24 ins diam bears N 63° E 39 lks dist marked T 1 S R 37 E S 36 BT.
- A fir 24 ins diam bears N 20° W 20 lks dist marked T 1 S R 37 E S 35 BT.
- A fir 24 ins diam bears S 74° W 34 lks dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 2 BT.
- A fir 24 ins diam bears S 74° E 21 lks dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 1 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

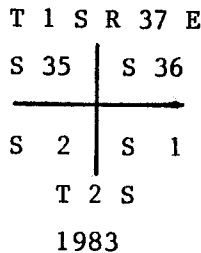
- Found a fir 36 ins diam for Section 2 bearing tree with healed blazes.
- Found a root hole for Sections 1 and 35 bearing trees.
- Did not find original wood post or Section 36 bearing tree.



Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ inch aluminum cap on a 2 inch aluminum pipe 30 inches long 26 inches in the ground with 4 inches projecting out of the ground with a surrounding earthen mound. (No rock available within limits.) Set a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 attached.

Aluminum cap marked thus:

New bearing trees:

- A tamarack 18 ins diam bears S 28° E, 40.3 feet dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 1 BT
- A tamarack 10 ins diam bears N 43° E, 24.4 feet dist marked T 1 S R 37 E S 36 BT
- A tamarack 9 ins diam bears N 14° W, 45.0 feet dist marked T 1 S R 37 E S 35 BT

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze. A sign 54-4 is attached on opposite side of tree from BT blaze.
