

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

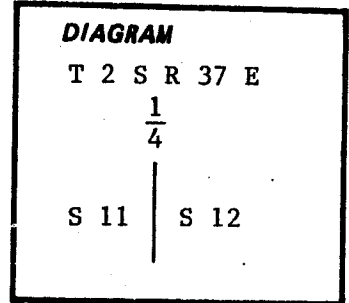
Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract no. 450 dated June 11, 1882.

Surveyor General records state:

Set stone 14 x 9 x 7 ins 10 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec corner marked 1/4 on N face, from which;

A fir 15 ins diam bears N 38° W, 12 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.

A fir 5 ins diam bears S 44° E, 4 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

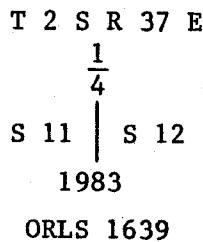
NONE, corner position has been obliterated by previous logging operations and monument placed at proportionate location from adjacent section corners North and South.

NOTE: A fence corner bears N 81° W, 48 feet from reestablished corner position and from which the fence lines run East, West and North.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2 1/2 inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe 31 inches long and projecting 4 inches out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 attached.

Brass cap marked thus:



New bearing trees established:

A fir 11 ins diam bears N 10° E, 28.3 feet dist marked 1/4 S 12 BT.

A fir 9 ins diam bears S 67° W, 15.0 feet dist marked 1/4 S 11 BT.

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze. A sign 54-4 is attached on opposite side of tree from BT blaze.
