

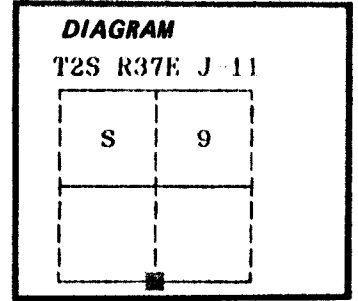
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set post 3 ft. long 3 in. square 24 in. in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 S on N face, from which;

A Pine 6 in diam bears N23°E 34 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT
 A Pine 14 in diam bears S17°E 13 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or it's accessories.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees;

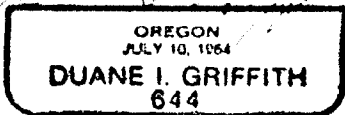
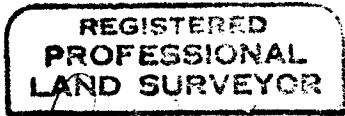
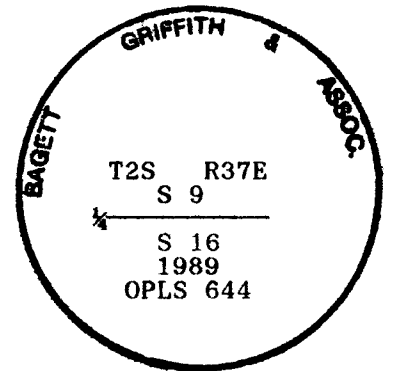
A 8 inch diameter Western Larch bears N14°E, 53.4 feet marked 1/4 S9 BT
 A 12 inch diameter Western Larch bears S81°W, 21.05 feet marked 1/4 S16 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 1, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
