
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set post 4 ft. long 4 in. square 24 in. in ground for Cor. to Secs. 9, 10, 15 & 16 marked T2S S10 on NE, R37E S9 on NW, S16 on SW and S15 on SE with 4 notches on S and 3 on E edges, from which;

A Pine 9 in diam bears N70°E 28 lks dist marked T2S S10 BT A Tamarack 17 in diam bears S27°E 7 lks dist marked S15 BT A Fir 15 in diam bears S53°W 27 lks dist marked S16 BT A Pine 9 in diam bears N20°W 35 lks dist marked R37E S9 BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found the rotted remains of the original corner post to a depth of 5 inches.

Found no evidence of the original Northeast bearing tree.

Found a tamarack stump rotted away to 10 inch diameter S27°E, 7 lks, with no marks visible.

Found a 37 inch diameter White Fir S53°W, 27 lks, live but sickly, chopped open with portion of the original blaze evident.

Found a root hole N20°W, 35 lks, wit of Lodgepole pine, no marks visible. with remains

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: In place of the found original corner post, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which:


New Bearing Trees; A 10 inch diameter Western Larch bears N10°E, 37.16 feet marked T2S R37E S10 BT A 10 inch diameter Western Larch bears S36°E, 57.75 feet marked T2S R37E S15 BT A 13 inch diameter Western Larch bears S4°W, 18.98 feet marked T2S R37E S16 BT A 13 inch diameter Western Larch bears N57°W, 40.8 feet marked T2S R37E S9 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 6, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
