

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

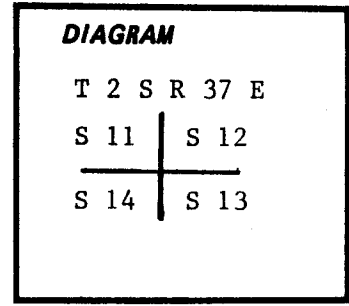
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract no. 450, dated June 11, 1882.

Surveyors General records state:

Set post 4 ft long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground for cor to Secs 11, 12, 13 & 14, marked T 2 S S 12 on NE, R 37 E S 11 on NW, S 14 on SW and S 13 on SE with 4 notches on S and 1 on E edges, from which:

- A pine 5 ins diam bears N 68° W, 31 lks dist marked R 37 E S 11 BT.
- A pine 8 ins diam bears S 50° E, 8 lks dist marked S 13 BT.
- A pine 5 ins diam bears N 40° E, 29 lks dist marked T 2 S S 12 BT.
- A tamarack 15 ins diam bears S 37° W, 17 lks dist marked S 14 BT.



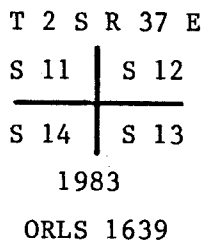
Description of corner evidence found:

Found a sawed tamarack stump with a portion of letter B on negative from BT blaze. No trace of other three bearing trees or original wood post.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined from original bearing tree and official record notes, set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe 31 inches long and buried 27 inches in the ground with 4 inches projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 attached.

Brass cap marked thus:



New bearing trees:

- A fir 9 ins diam bears N 18° E, 10.8 feet dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 12 BT.
- A fir 11 ins diam bears N 74° W, 20.2 feet dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 11 BT.
- A fir 7 ins diam bears S 50° E 5.5 feet dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 13 BT.
- A fir 6 ins diam bears S 19° W, 31.0 feet dist marked T 2 S R 37 E S 14 BT.

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 nailed below a 6 inch band of red paint and a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and a sign 54-4 nailed on opposite side of BT blaze.

The original BT stump has a sign 54-3 and 54-4 attached and is painted red.
