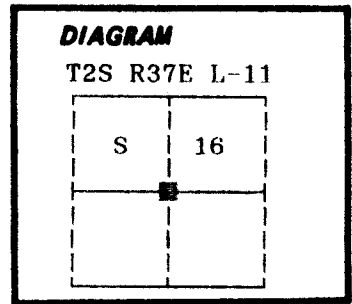


History of original corner establishment:

Corner not previously established.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Corner not previously established

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees:

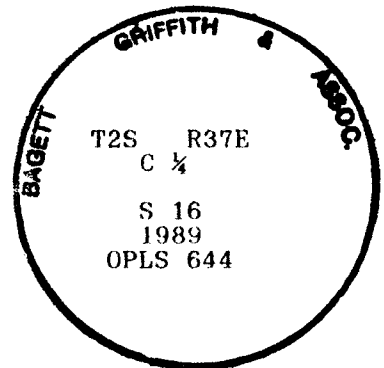
- A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S54°W, 69.73 feet marked X BT
- A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N16°W, 53.26 feet marked C 1/4 S16 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 2, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
