A 19" diameter White Fir bears South 20° West, a distance of 63.61 feet marked C1/4 S13 BT.


A 15" diameter Larch bears North 40° West, a distance of 52.56 feet marked C1/4 S13 BT.

I used a Leica TCA-1100 and prism in the establishment of the new accessories. The basis of bearings is the same as that shown on Survey No. 030-2002, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing tree. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
