
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:


New Bearing Trees; A 9 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N25°E, 74.75 feet marked S1/16 S16 BT A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N56°W, 28.23 feet marked S1/16 S17 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 2 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 17, 1989.
