
History of original corner establishment:

New Bearing Trees; A 10 inch diameter Western Larch bears N65°W, 42.64 feet marked CS1/16 S16 BT A 8 inch diameter Western Larch bears N11°W, 36.94 feet marked X BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached
