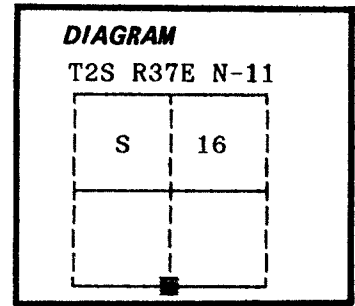


History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO contract number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set post 3 ft. long 3 in. square 24 in. in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4S on N face, from which;

A Pine 9 in diam bears N22°E 27 lks dist marked 1/4S BT
A Pine 10 in diam bears S37°W 12 lks dist marked 1/4S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or it's accessories.

See map of survey dated November, 1989.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees:

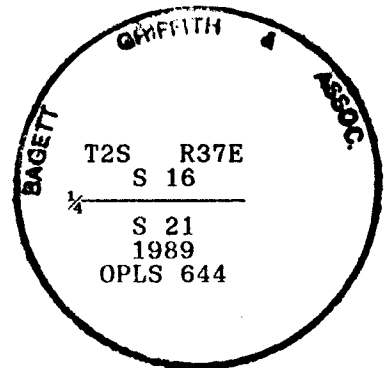
A 9 inch diameter Western Larch bears N25°E, 29.45 feet marked 1/4 S16 BT
A 10 inch diameter Western Larch bears S85°E, 24.53 feet marked 1/4 S21 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 2, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
