
History of original corner establishment: Corner not previously established.

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Tree and Bearing Object;
A ½"x30" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA MARKER bears N20°E, 5.71 feet.
A 13 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N50°W, 110.88 feet marked SW1/16 S19 BT


Painted a 6 inch red band around the BT and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.
