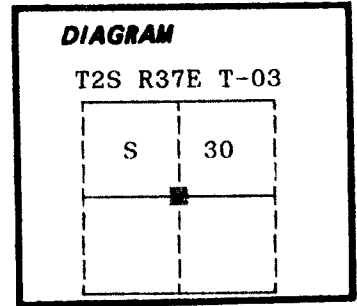


History of original corner establishment:

Corner not previously established.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Corner not previously established

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 29 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees;

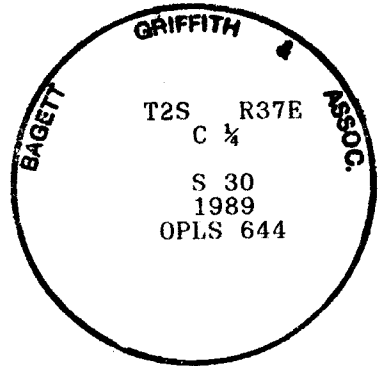
- A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N51°E, 36.15 feet marked X BT
- A 8 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S37°E, 70.0 feet marked X BT
- A 15 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N6°W, 28.06 feet marked C 1/4 S30 BT
- A 12 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N73°W, 51.46 feet marked C 1/4 S30 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on November 10, 1989.
