
History of original corner establishment: Corner not previously established.

Description of corner evidence found:

Corner not previously established See map of survey dated November, 1989.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees; A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S37°E, 32.46 feet marked CE1/16 S30 BT A 9 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S47°W, 42.07 feet marked CE1/16 S30 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.


Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument and property boundary signs attached.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on November 10, 1989.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
