
### CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

#### History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry Meldrum under GLO Contract Number 450, dated June 11, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

ost 3 ft. long, 3 in. square, 24 in. in ground for ¼ Sec. marked ¼S on W face from which;

A Tamarack 4 in. diam bears N56°E, 14 lks. dist. marked ¼S BT A Pine 40 in. diam. bears S80°W, 12 lks. dist. marked ¼S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.

Found a 8 inch diameter Tamařack N56°E, 14 lks dist, dead and down with scribes visible.

Found the remains of a large Ponderosa Pine stump 880°W, 12 lks dist, rotting with no scribing visible

Found fence post set by the BLM 2 ft. North and 1 ft West of the true corner position.

### Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At record distance from the found bearing trees. I set 2%"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, fisch;


New Bearing Trees;
A 22 lucb diameter Tamarack bears N13°E, 48.43 feet marked ½ S27 BT
A 10 inch diameter Tamarack bears S77°E, 12.18 feet marked ½ BT
A 11 inch diameter Tamarack bears S12°W, 51.38 feet marked XX BT
A 11 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N71°W, 71.66 feet marked ½ S28 BT

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with Attention sign artached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 18, 1991.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
