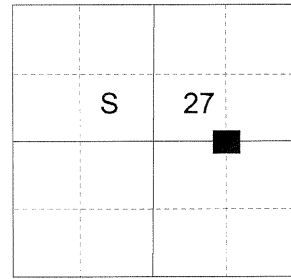

At the position by survey I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin 26" in the ground with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

**NEW BEARING TREES:**

A 4" Douglas Fir bears North 56° East a dist. of 9.50 ft., marked CE 1/16 S27 BT.  
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 64° West a dist. of 13.60 ft., marked CE 1/16 S27 BT.

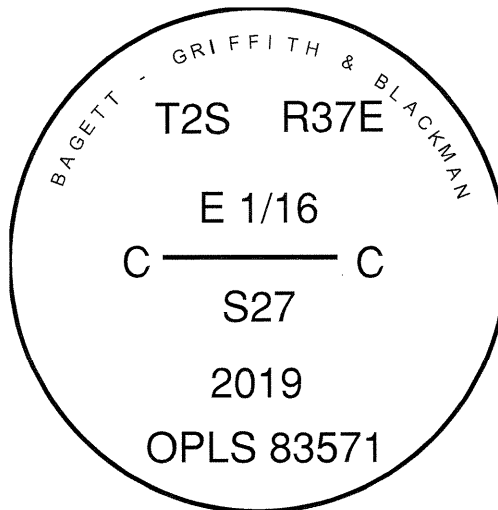
Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. The bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
