
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner not previously established.




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which:

New BTs: A 10 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S5°E, 30.1 feet marked X BT A 14 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N80°W, 18.33 feet marked CE 1/16 S31 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with property boundary and land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on January 8, 1989.
