Corner established by T. Davenport under GLO contract no. 102 dated July 20, 1863.

Description of corner evidence found:

At approximate corner position found a live pine 22 ins diam and a live pine 31 ins diam both of which fit original notes with respect to each other.

I opened the 22 inch pine and after going through 6 inches of overgrowth found BT scribes. By ring count this blaze was made 110 years ago which is consistent with the record being 120 years. Did not open the 31 inch pine.

NOTE: The 22 inch pine was recorded in 1863 as being 18 inches diam, however, I believe it should have been recorded as being 8 inches diam.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch aluminum cap on a 2 inch aluminum pipe projecting 7 inches out of the ground and a surrounding rock mound. Placed a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 attached.

No trees available within limits in Section 32, therefore, marked a boulder 2 ft x 2 ft x 4 ft with a X which bears N 42 $^{\circ}$ E, 11.3 ft dist. Boulder is painted red around X and has sign 54-3 and 54-4 wired around.

Original bearing trees have a sign 54-3 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and a sign 54-4 attached on opposite side of tree from BT blaze.
