At the intersection of the centerline of Hunter Road and the projected East and West fence lines I

set a 2½" x 30" Copper Clad monument with cap in a valve box marked as shown below, 30" in the ground from which:

A 5/8" iron pin with 1/1/2" aluminum cap bears S51°W, a distance of 38.83 feet, marked UNION COUNTY SURVEY MARKER SW RP.

A 5/8" iron pin with 1/1/2" aluminum cap bears $S58^{\circ}E$, a distance of 32.45 feet, marked UNION COUNTY SURVEY MARKER SE RP.

A 5/8" iron pin with 1/1/2" aluminum cap bears N55°E, a distance of 31.40 feet, marked UNION COUNTY SURVEY MARKER NE RP.


A Power Pole with a 60d spike 0.10 off ground bears N30°W, a distance of 48.30 feet, Power Pole number #035035084.
